For best user experience, please use these recommended computer browsers:

PC users - Internet Explorer and Mac users - Firefox

To prevent the accidental loss of application information, we strongly recommend:

- Draft answers to the application questions in a Word document. Save this document to your computer, and copy and paste the information into the application fields when you're ready to submit.
- Use the Save option (located at the bottom of each page) every fifteen minutes to ensure information is not lost.
- Click on Save and View whenever completing a "page" of the application.

When returning to an in-progress application, go to the My Applications tab and select Edit in order to return to your application.

To Avoid Losing Access to your Grantee Center User Account:

- Log out of the application before you close your browser to end your session in Grantee Center. If the session ends without a user having logged off, the user account will be locked for 3 hours.

Please note: If your Grantee Center user session lasts longer than 3 hours, the system will time you out and automatically end your session. The user account will become locked.
